Worksite Survey Highlights—June 30, 2003

Demographics

- 214 worksites completed the survey
- The average number of employees was 39
- The number of employees ranged from 1 to 1,100

Smoking Policy

- 36% have a formal written policy, 42% have an informal policy, 19% do not have a smoking policy
- 78% do not allow their employees to smoke anywhere inside, 18% allow their employees to smoke inside in designated areas, 4% allow their employees to smoke anywhere inside
- 84% of the worksites with smoking policies thought the policy was followed all of the time
- 62% posted visible signage indicating their policy

Assistance

- Of the 214 surveyed, 11 were interested in assistance with developing or improving existing smoking policies
- 51 were interested in programs that could help employees quit using tobacco products
- 20% offered insurance plans that cover tobacco cessation products or programs
- 8% offered tobacco cessation programs for employees
